

South Pole Extreme is a superb challenge for any adventurer with polar ambitions. Antarctica's high plateau is one of the most exacting environments on Earth and this expedition immerses you into its very core.



From Punta Arenas, Chile we fly south to Antarctica spending two days at Union Glacier camp where we acclimatise to the cold, do some local ski training and complete final preparations for our ski expedition.

A Twin Otter aircraft takes us on a magical flight across the Antarctic plateau to 890 south where we set up camp and become accustomed to our surroundings and the 2400m altitude. The following day we begin the great trek south.

A unique wilderness experience, the Antarctic plateau is like no other place on earth. With temperatures between -20 and -30C the cold is ever-present but comfortably so in state-of-the-art cold weather clothing and equipment. In true polar fashion, you tow manageable sleds of approximately 40kg containing all your food and equipment.

You will experience twenty four-hour daylight so there's no shortage of time to really see and feel authentic Antarctica. We average 15 km per day as we make our way to the South



Pole, working as a team, immersing ourselves in the elements, camping in expedition tents, experiencing the high Antarctic hinterland as it has been for millennia.

On our epic arrival at the bottom of the Earth we visit the South Pole station before setting up camp for a night at the Pole. The following day we are collected by Twin Otter and flown back to Union Glacier where we celebrate our achievement in style. We return to Punta Arenas the next day.

DAY	ACTIVITY
1	Arrive Punta Arenas and check-in to hotel
2	Meet with your guide. Review itinerary, equipment and food. Final preparations for departure to Antarctica
3-4	Fly to Union Glacier base in Antarctica (weather dependent). Set up camp and finalise expedition preparation activities, including sled packing and pulling, skiing, camp procedures and equipment tweaking.
4	Flight to 89 south. Camp. Final acclimatization to altitude
5-12	Ski expedition to the South Geographic Pole (8 days)
12	Flight from South Pole to Union Glacier (weather dependent)
14	Flight from Union Glacier to Punta Arenas, weather dependent. Celebration dinner

Antarctic weather can be unpredictable and delays in polar flights can occur. You are advised to book flexible tickets.
